THE CAMPAIGN FOR BRATTLEBORO MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

Update on the BMH Outpatient Building projects –

- ◆ The BMH building project has been in the planning stages at the internal, local and state levels since 2002.
- ◆ The hospital has contracted with H.P. Cummings of Woodsville, NH, for construction management. Local subcontractors will be used as much as possible.
- ◆ Our architects, Williams & Frehsee of Brattleboro, are finalizing the designs and preparing construction documents for the new building and the ACU renovation.
- ◆ BMH plans to start the renovation of the existing Ambulatory Care Unit in spring of 2007. The groundbreaking for the new Outpatient Building is planned for a month later.
- ◆ The hospital has received its local permits and is currently awaiting Act 250 approvals while it continues to address neighbors' suggestions.

About the Capital Campaign for BMH –

- ◆ Co-chairs former Senator Robert T. Gannett and Mark Richards are leading a campaign committee of over fifty volunteers who have set the goal, approved by the hospital board, of a minimum of \$2.5 million to be raised from the community for partial financing of the BMH Outpatient Building project. Other funds needed for the project will come from internal sources and borrowing.
- ◆ The campaign is now in its advanced stages with several divisions currently underway. The public will be invited to help with contributions to the *Building on Excellence* campaign after the first of next year.
