THE CAMPAIGN FOR BRATTLEBORO MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

Update on the BMH Outpatient Building projects –

- ◆ The hospital groundbreaking for the new BMH Outpatient Center will be June 21st and construction will take approximately 18 months to complete.
- ◆ The hospital has contracted with H.P. Cummings of Woodsville, NH, for construction management. Local subcontractors have been invited to bid on the project. The bid process will end on June 12th.
- ◆ When construction begins, a fence will be erected around the construction site. The back entrance to the BMH ground level near Brew Barry Conference Center will no longer be accessible.
- ◆ BMH plans to start the renovation of the existing Ambulatory Care Unit in the Fall.
- ◆ The hospital staff looks forward to being able to provide more comfortable and convenient services for our patients and their families.

About the Capital Campaign for BMH –

- ◆ Co-chairs former Senator Robert T. Gannett and Mark Richards, who are leading the *Building for Excellence* campaign committee of over fifty volunteers, announce they are well on their way to raising a minimum of \$2.5 million for partial financing of the BMH Outpatient Building project. Other funds needed for the project will come from internal sources and borrowing.
- ◆ The campaign is now in its advanced stages with several divisions currently underway. To date, more than \$1.7 million has been raised from initial efforts, including businesses, medical staff, and hospital employees – with that campaign in particular already having raised \$70,000 before it even officially kicks off. The public will be invited to help with contributions to the *Building on Excellence* campaign in the Fall.
